

Dear competitors,

Thank you for entering the CAI2*/3* Bornem on the grounds of De Schelderuiters. The program and directions can be found on our website [WWW. SCHELDERUITERS.BE](http://WWW.SCHELDERUITERS.BE) and on FB CAI Bornem. Provisional starting orders and other important information will also be published there. Please keep in mind all information is subject to change.

Arrival

- The showground will be open for arrival on Tuesday 16th May from 9:00 till 19:00. By emergency call Cathy +32 477 69 88 82
- Record the temperature of each of your horses 3 days before their arrival on the FEI HorseApp.
- Fill in the Self-Certification Form for each of your horses on the FEI HorseApp.
- Bring your own thermometer!
- All horses must have their temperatures taken under the supervision of a veterinarian before entering the stables. This also applies to horses stabled by the trucks in own stabling. When your horses have been checked, they can be brought to the stables.

Stables

- The stables are by name and there are lists at the entrance of the tents on which you can see which boxes are reserved for you. A list will be posted at the entrance of the tents indicating which stalls have been assigned to you.
- Stable lanes must be kept clear at all times.
- Stalls will be bedded with straw and shavings (if pre-indicated).
- Extra straw can be purchased via the Show office for €10 per bale.
- Extra shavings/hay can be purchased via the Show Office for €12 per bale.

Course walk

- There is no official exploration of the marathon sections. You can explore the A and B sections by bike or on foot. Motorized traffic in the A and B section is NOT allowed. The obstacles are officially open for exploration from Thursday 18 May at 8:00 (unofficially opened from Tuesday 16 May at 11 am).

Additional info

- Come to the Show office for your competition file + declaration form. If you want BBQ on Saturday, book by mail cathy@kruiskeshof.be or at the latest at the Show office on Thursday 18 May until 12 noon. You can also place orders for the bakery at the show office, the day before until noon.
- Make your payment in order before the start of the competition, invoice only on request.
